

Day 2: Travel to Masai Mara

Wednesday Nov 5, 2025

After an early breakfast we set off on our journey to the Masai Mara. Our accommodation is located in the heart of this famous reserve.

Make sure you keep an eye out along the way, you never know when you might see a stray elephant or warthog wandering near the Mara.

At 30 miles in length, the Mara River is best known for the dramatic and legendary wildebeest crossing, shown in wildlife documentaries worldwide. Tonight, we'll spend the evening sitting back and watching the locals frolic on the plains in front of the lodge. And we're talking about the animals! Look out for elephants, crocodiles, hippos and zebras among others.



Day 3: Game Drives in the Mara/Optional Balloon Experience

Thursday Nov 6, 2025

Located in the south-west corner of Kenya, the Masai Mara National Reserve is one of the most famous wildlife parks in Africa. The park is teeming with wildlife and is one of the best places for wildlife viewing in Kenya. You might not want to blink in case you miss something! Return to your lodge for a sundowner and an evening under the stars. Today you can opt to see wildlife from a different angle on a balloon flight above the Mara plains.

For guests arriving in Nairobi today, we will meet you at JKIA and transfer you to Mary's House in Nairobi.



Day 5: Transfer to Soysambu Conservancy, afternoon game drives Saturday Nov 8, 2025

Escape to the serene beauty of Soysambu Conservancy. Settle into your accommodation before heading out on an afternoon game drive. Soysambu Conservancy was established in 2007 and its 48,000acres is home to spectacular Rift Valley Wildlife such as the rare Rothschild giraffe, various antelope species, leopard, lion and hyena.

Meet some of the researchers based at Soysambu to gain a better understanding of the challenges facing wildlife in Kenya and some of the innovative approaches used in conservation.

Day 6: Game Drives Lake Nakuru & Gilgil Weavers Sunday Nov 9, 2025

We will start our day with game drives at Lake Nakuru National Park. This is one of the few parks where you can see both black and white rhino as well as a host of water birds and antelope which make their home along the water's edge. It's a delightful introduction to the region, combining cultural exploration with relaxation.

Day 10: Scat Dogs & Conservation

Thursday Nov 13, 2025

One of the key tools to surveying cheetah in the area is the use of Scat Detection Dogs - Persi and Madi. These canine ACK team members are at the forefront of conservation innovation. Persi and Madi can differentiate cheetah scat from other predator faeces, which then enables the ACK team to survey large sections



of the conservancy. This helps to inform the team of the numbers of cheetah in the area and to understand cheetah land usage and movement with greater accuracy.

Spend a morning with Persi and Madi and see if you can find cheetah poop as quickly as the canine experts!

Day 11: ACK Community Project

Transfer to Samburu National Reserve. Samburu is located north of Nairobi on the edge of the great arid rangelands of northern Kenya. Lying in the shadows of the imposing Ololokwe and Koitoger mountains, the reserve is the heartland of the Samburu people and home to a range of unique species such as the Grevy's zebra, gerenuk and beisa oryx. The reserve is also known for its large elephant herds, lions, leopards, and cheetah. Enjoy a day of game drives in this peaceful and tranquil wildlife haven.

Day 13: Samburu Game Drives and local researchers Sunday Nov 16, 2025

Be prepared for an early wake up call with tea or coffee delivered to your room. Head out on a dawn game drive and see what amazing wildlife is up as early as you are. Cheetah conservation is a small part of maintaining the biodiversity. Samburu is home to the field bases for Ewaso Lions and Grevy's Zebra Trust. We will invite researchers from the projects to join us for a meal and discussion. Finish your day with a sundowner on the edge of the Ewaso Nyiro River.
